

Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370)

Construction of Subway in support of the
Provision of Columbarium at On Hing Lane, Shek Mun, Shatin**

General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. CE81/I/GZ/001 (“the Plan”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed works are required to provide a safe, convenient and comfortable subway underneath Tate’s Cairn Highway connecting On Muk Street and the proposed columbarium at On Hing Lane, Shek Mun, Shatin.


2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows –
 - (i) construction of a subway to connect On Muk Street and the proposed columbarium at On Hing Lane, Shek Mun, Shatin;
 - (ii) construction of a footpath;
 - (iii) permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing amenity area into footpath;
 - (iv) demolition and conversion of sections of the existing slopes into the subway in (i) and footpaths; and
 - (v) ancillary works including lighting and drainage works, and installation of street furniture and traffic aids.

Roads to be Closed

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 17 of the Ordinance may be exercised to close permanently a section of the existing amenity area; and temporarily sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths within the limit of works area as shown on the Plan. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period as and when required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths and amenity area are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Ordinance as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

4. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any existing utility service apparatus, such as electricity cables, telecommunication cables, water mains, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and such road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
