

ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)

(Notice under section 8(2))

SITE FORMATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS FOR  
PUBLIC HOUSING DEVELOPMENTS AT TSEUNG KWAN O

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Acting Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. GZ/001 to GZ/005 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) improvement works at the junction of Ying Yip Road/Po Ning Road/Sheung Ning Road, including widening of sections of the existing Ying Yip Road, Po Ning Road and Sheung Ning Road;
- (ii) modification of a roundabout at the junction of Ying Yip Road/Po Ning Road/Sheung Ning Road to an at-grade signal-controlled junction;
- (iii) widening of the existing traffic light controlled pedestrian crossings at Yau Yue Wan Village Road and Po Lam Road North;
- (iv) construction of a carriageway at Ying Yip Road and at the junction of Ying Yip Road/Po Ning Road;
- (v) construction of footpaths along Ying Yip Road, Po Ning Road, Yau Yue Wan Village Road and Pak Shing Kok Road;
- (vi) construction of a lay-by at Ying Yip Road;
- (vii) construction of a footbridge and associated lift at Ying Yip Road;
- (viii) construction of traffic light controlled pedestrian crossings at Ying Yip Road and Chiu Shun Road;
- (ix) construction of tracks near Ying Yip Road and Po Lam Road North;
- (x) construction of run-ins/run-outs at Po Lam Road North, Yau Yue Wan Village Road and Pak Shing Kok Road;
- (xi) construction of pedestrian crossings at Pak Shing Kok Road and Ngan O Road;
- (xii) demolition and conversion of sections of the existing slopes into carriageways, footpaths, lay-bys, track and central medians/traffic islands;
- (xiii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, lay-by, central medians/traffic islands and amenity area;
- (xiv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways, lay-bys, central median/ traffic island and covered footpath;
- (xv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing tracks into carriageway and footpaths;
- (xvi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing central medians/ traffic islands into carriageways;
- (xvii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing amenity areas into carriageways, footpaths, lay-bys and central medians/ traffic islands;
- (xviii) permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing tracks near Ying Yip Road and Po Lam Road North;
- (xix) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing footpaths and central medians/traffic islands;
- (xx) ancillary works including site formation, installation of noise barrier, geotechnical, landscaping, drainage, electrical and mechanical works, and construction of retaining walls and slopes.

Any person who wishes to object to the works or the use, or both, is required to address to the Secretary for Transport and Housing an objection in writing, which can be submitted via one of the following means:—

The objector should describe his interest and the manner in which he alleges that he will be affected by the works or the use in his notice of objection. Objectors are requested to provide contact details to facilitate communication. A notice of objection should be delivered to the Secretary for Transport and Housing not later than 3rd day of March 2020.

Personal Information Collection Statement

Any information, including the personal data, submitted to the Secretary for Transport and Housing in connection with any written objections/comments will be used for the processing of the objections/comments and other related purposes. The provision of any information, including the personal data, other than the information as required under section 10(2) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) is voluntary. However, it may not be possible to process the objections/comments if such information, including the personal data, is not sufficiently provided. Any information, including the personal data, so submitted may be disclosed to the relevant government departments and other persons, organizations or agencies which are required to handle the objections/comments and related matters. Persons who have so submitted their personal data have the rights to request access to and correction of their personal data held by us.
