ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (CHAPTER 370) AS APPLIED BY SECTION 26 OF THE WATER POLLUTION CONTROL (SEWERAGE) REGULATION (CHAPTER 358AL)

PWP Item Nos. B764CL and B861CL Site Formation and Infrastructure Works for Public Housing Developments at San Hing Road and Hong Po Road, Tuen Mun (Sewerage Works)

General Description of the Works

The Director of Environmental Protection proposes to execute the sewerage works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan Nos. 5208968-SHHP-GAZ-1010 to 5208968-SHHP-GAZ-1013 (4 sheets) (the "Plans") annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed sewerage works are to serve the public housing developments at San Hing Road and Hong Po Road, Tuen Mun.

The general nature of the proposed sewerage works is as follows: –

- (i) construction of about 2,500 metres of gravity sewers and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (ii) construction of about 600 metres of twin rising mains, one sewage pumping station and associated manholes within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans;
- (iii) upgrading of about 200 metres of existing gravity sewer within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans; and
- (iv) ancillary works including temporary closure and reinstatement of carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, and central medians / refuge islands or parts thereof.

Roads to be Closed

For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Director of Environmental Protection proposes that powers under section 17 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358AL) may be exercised to close temporarily or permanently the existing carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, and central medians / refuge islands or parts thereof within the limit of works area as shown on the Plans. Temporary alternative access will be provided and temporary diversions will be carried out during the construction period where required. Further notice, setting out the manner in which such carriageways, footpaths, cycle tracks, and central medians / refuge islands or parts thereof are to be closed, will be issued under section 18 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358AL) as and when required.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

5. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Director of Environmental Protection proposes that powers under section 20 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter

370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358AL) may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of the existing utility service apparatus, such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water-mains, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such service apparatus is to be altered and any road surface is to be repaired, will be issued under section 20 of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) as applied by section 26 of the Water Pollution Control (Sewerage) Regulation (Chapter 358AL) as and when required.
