KAI TAK DEVELOPMENT—INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS FOR DEVELOPMENTS
AT THE SOUTHERN PART OF THE FORMER RUNWAY—
JUNCTION IMPROVEMENTS AT WANG CHIU ROAD IN KOWLOON BAY

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. 60022408/S3/1.2 ('the Plan') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plan and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) modification of the junctions of Wang Chiu Road and Kai Cheung Road, Wang Chiu Road and Lam Hing Street, and Wang Chiu Road and Sheung Yee Road;
- (ii) construction of carriageway, footpath, and pedestrian crossing;
- (iii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into central medians/traffic islands or pedestrian crossings;
- (iv) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways or pedestrian crossings;
- (v) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing central medians/traffic islands into carriageways or pedestrian crossings;
- (vi) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands; and
- (vii) ancillary works including drainage, utilities and landscaping works.
