**ROADS (WORKS, USE AND COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE (Chapter 370)**

(Notice under section 8(2))

KAI TAK DEVELOPMENT—  
INFRASTRUCTURE AT NORTH APRON AREA OF KAI TAK AIRPORT  
STAGE 3 INFRASTRUCTURE WORKS**

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance'), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plans Nos. 23462/GAZ/1.1, 23462/GAZ/1.2 and 23462/GAZ/1.3 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto, which the Plans and scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed works is as follows:—

- (i) construction of Roads D1 (part), L1, L2 (part), L11, as well as two slip roads linking San Po Kong Area and Prince Edward Road East of approximately 1 900 metres (m) long in total and associated footpaths;
- (ii) construction of a landscaped elevated walkway LW4 of approximately 285 m long across Prince Edward Road East;
- (iii) construction of an underpass VT1 to form part of the proposed Road L1 in (i);
- (iv) construction of 2 sections of a pedestrian subway SW2 of approximately 255 m long in total across Prince Edward Road East and Road D1 (part);
- (v) construction of a pedestrian subway extension SW3 of approximately 60 m long;
- (vi) widening and re-alignment of Concorde Road to form part of the proposed Road D1 (part) in (i);
- (vii) widening and re-alignment of Eastern Road to form part of the proposed Road L2 (part) in (i);
- (viii) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths or amenity area;
- (ix) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into central medians/traffic islands;
- (x) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into carriageways or amenity area;
- (xi) permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing footpaths into central medians/traffic islands;
- (xii) permanent closure and demolition of the existing flyover across Prince Edward Road East and Eastern Road;
- (xiii) permanent closure of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths;
- (xiv) temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways and footpaths; and
- (xv) ancillary works including drainage, water, utility and landscaping works.
