Amendments under section 7

Notice is hereby given that under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) ('the Ordinance'), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to amend the works originally shown on Plans Nos. 231448/GAZ-A/001 to 231448/GAZ-A/003 ('the Plans') and described in the scheme annexed thereto. The Plans and scheme were referred to in G.N.1834 published under section 8(2) of the Ordinance on 27 February 2015 and 6 March 2015. The proposed amendments are shown on Amendment Plans Nos. 231448/GAZ-A/101 to 231448/GAZ-A/103 ('the Amendment Plans') and described in the amendment scheme annexed thereto, which the Amendment Plans and amendment scheme have been deposited in the Land Registry.

The general nature of the proposed amendments to the works is as follows:—

- (i) revision of the originally proposed limit of works area;
- (ii) revision of resumption/clearance limit as shown on Resumption Plan No. DNM3117a annexed hereto;
- (iii) construction of a pick-up/drop-off area at Sha Ling Road;
- (iv) construction of two emergency vehicular accesses (EVA): EVA1 connecting to Sha Ling Road and EVA2 connecting to Road B;
- (v) construction of carriageways and footpaths;
- (vi) deletion of the originally proposed Road A;
- (vii) revision of alignment of the originally proposed Road B;
- (viii) deletion of sections of the originally proposed carriageways, footpaths and slope works;
- (ix) deletion of sections of the originally proposed carriageways, and replaced by proposed footpaths, central medians/traffic islands and slope works;
- (x) deletion of sections of the originally proposed footpaths, and replaced by proposed carriageways, central medians/traffic islands and slope works;
- (xi) deletion of part of the originally proposed slope works, and replaced by proposed carriageways, footpaths and central medians/traffic islands;
- (xii) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing carriageway into footpath, and replaced by permanent closure and conversion of a section of the existing carriageway into central median/traffic island;
- (xiii) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths, and replaced by temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageway;
- (xiv) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing carriageways, and replaced by permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths;
- (xv) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing carriageways, and replaced by permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into slope works;

- (xvi) deletion of the originally proposed permanent closure and demolition of sections of the existing carriageways, and replaced by temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways;
- (xvii) deletion of the originally proposed temporary closure and reconstruction of sections of the existing carriageways, and replaced by permanent closure and conversion of sections of the existing carriageways into footpaths and central medians/traffic islands; and
- (xviii) revision of the proposed ancillary works including waterworks, drainage, sewerage, slope, retaining structures and landscaping works.
