
General Description of the Works

Under powers delegated by the Secretary for Transport and Housing under section 3(3) of the Roads (Works, Use and Compensation) Ordinance (Chapter 370) (“the Ordinance”), the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes to execute the road works within the limit of works area as shown on Plan No. KZ840 (“the Plan”) annexed hereto and described hereunder. The proposed road works are required to provide infrastructure necessary to serve the development of West Kowloon Cultural District.

2. The general nature of the proposed works is as follows –
 - (i) construction of a carriageway of approximately 500 metres long below the proposed ground level with associated footpaths, pick-up/drop-off areas, pedestrian crossings and central medians/traffic islands; and
 - (ii) ancillary works including civil and structural engineering, mechanical and electrical, drainage, water and utilities works.

Apparatus whose Course or Position to be Altered

3. For the purposes of or incidental to the works or the use, the Permanent Secretary for Transport and Housing (Transport) proposes that powers under section 20 of the Ordinance may be exercised to require alteration of the course or position of any existing utility services apparatus such as electricity cables and ducts, telecommunication cables and ducts, water mains, drainage pipes, gas pipes and any other service apparatus lying within the limit of works area, and to require repairing of any road surface thereby disturbed. Further notice, setting out the manner in which the course or position of such apparatus is to be altered and the repair of any road surface, will be issued under section 20 of the Ordinance as and when required.
