

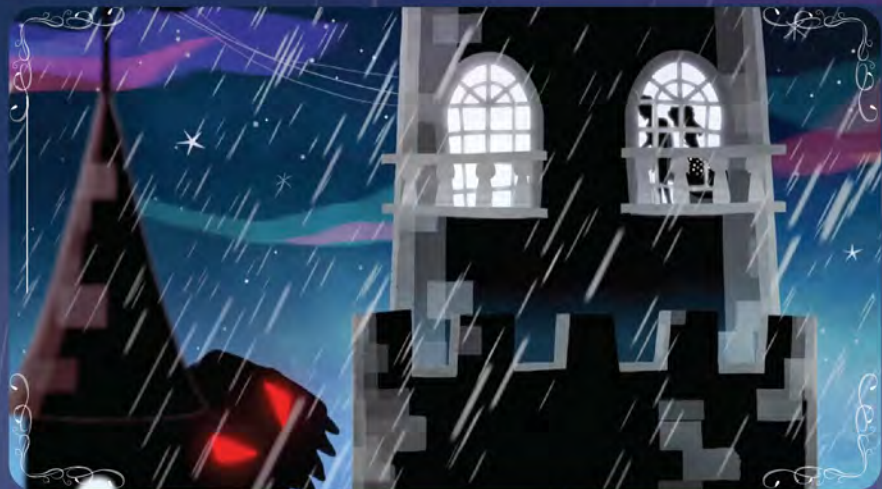


Landslide Self-help Tips



Already Indoor

Stay at Home or in a Safe Shelter



You should cancel non-essential appointments, stay at home or remain in a safe shelter, and pay attention to news of weather and other warnings.



For residents close to slopes, stay in rooms on higher floors and/or furthest away from slopes.

Keep Vigilant



Keep vigilant, monitor the condition and watch out for signs of landslide danger closely.

Pay Attention to Evacuation Notices



If you have received a notification to evacuate from rescuer or believe that your home could be endangered by landslide risks, you should leave immediately if condition permits.

Escape by using an exit away from slopes. Stay temporarily at a safe shelter (e.g. relatives' home, village office, or temporary shelter provided by the District Offices or nearby safe shelter provided by voluntary agencies).

Still Outside

Keep Away From Slopes



Pedestrians should try to stay away from slopes.



If possible, use alternative route away from the slopes.



Motorists should avoid using the roads with landslide warning signs. Otherwise, please drive through with safe speed. Do not stop unnecessarily.
